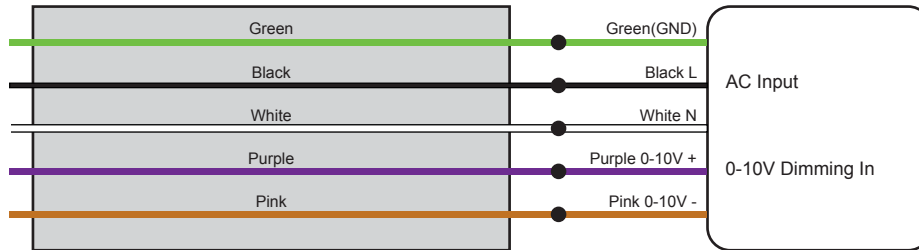

WIRING DIAGRAM



1. For not dimmable or forward & reverse phase dimming, use only black (L), white (N) & Green (GND).
2. Don't use 0-10V and Forward & Reverse Phase dimming together.

RETROFIT INSTALLATION

NOTE: This product is not intended for retrofitting Insulation-Contact enclosures. The enclosure would need to be removed before installation of this luminaire.

1. Make sure the POWER IS TURNED OFF at the source before retrofitting the luminaire.
2. If accessories are needed please go see appropriate accessories installation, in the accessory section (p. 3)
3. If existing lamp and trim are present, remove from ceiling or move it out of the way as it will not be needed during installation.(fig.1) Measure the ceiling opening to make sure the edge of the luminaire will cover the entire hole and still sit firmly in the ceiling before proceeding. See dimension tables for more information.
4. Attach the carabiner safety clip to the existing mounting plate.(fig. 2)
5. Remove J-box faceplate. Disconnect all wires to the ballast and remove ballast from J-Box. Remove appropriate round knock out and attach the fixture conduit whip into knock out. Follow wiring diagram for connection, using the provided connectors. Reattach J-box faceplate. (fig. 3)
6. Adjust the fixture power to desired lumen output by sliding the blue selector switch. Adjust the color temperature to desired one, by sliding the orange selector switch. Make sure the switch is never in between positions. (fig. 4)
7. Squeeze the two spring clips so they are in an upright position and insert lamp into mounting plate. (fig. 5)
8. Once fixture is inside the plate, release the spring clips and continue pushing fixture until securely fixed and flush with ceiling. (fig. 6)
9. Restore power at the source and the installation is complete.

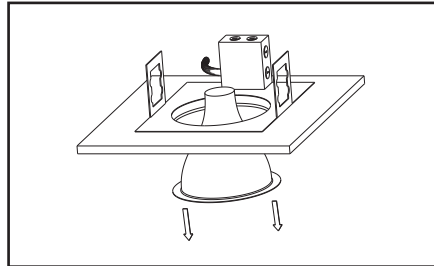

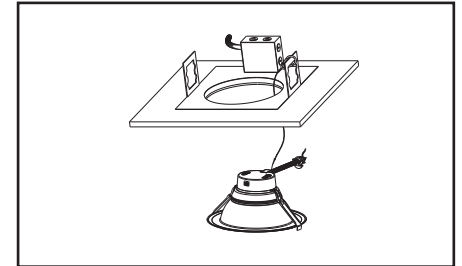

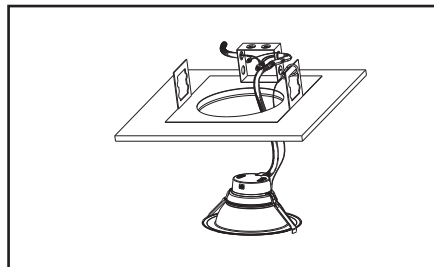

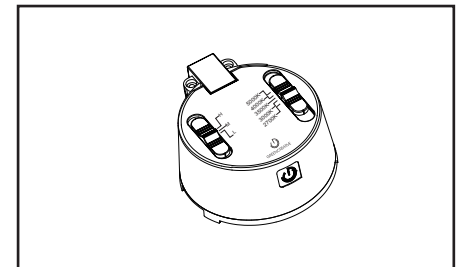

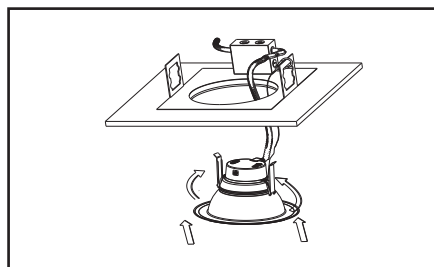
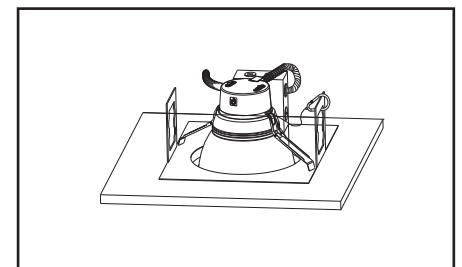

DIRECT MOUNT AND NEW CONSTRUCTION INSTALLATION

1. Make sure the POWER IS TURNED OFF at the source to the location in which you are installing the product.
2. If accessories are needed please go see appropriate accessories installation, in the accessory section (p. 3)
3. If using a new Construction Plate, install it in the ceiling following its own installation instruction. (fig. 1)
4. If a new hole is needed, use a hole cutter and set the diameter according to the dimensional table, or cut along the edge of the new construction plate prepared for the desired size (fig. 2).
5. Attach the carabiner safety clip to a secure place inside the ceiling. (fig. 3)
6. Adjust the fixture power to desired lumen output by sliding the blue selector switch. Adjust the color temperature to desired one, by sliding the orange selector switch. Make sure the switch is never in between positions. (fig. 4)
7. Insert luminaire conduit into a preinstalled J-box by other or into the New Construction Frame J-box. and wire to the power source following wiring diagram (p. 1). Squeeze the two spring clips so they are in an upright position and insert lamp in the ceiling. (fig. 5)
8. Once lamp is inside the ceiling, release the spring clips and continue pushing fixture until securely fixed and flush with ceiling. (fig. 6)
9. Restore power at the source and the installation is complete.

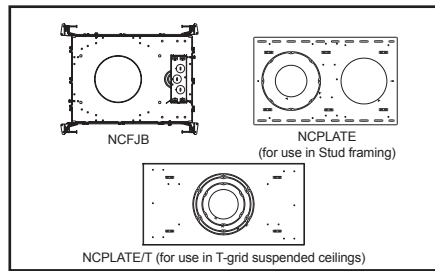

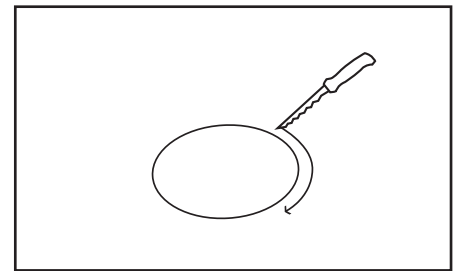

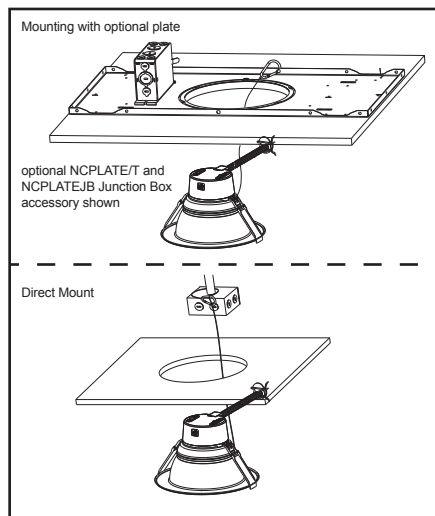

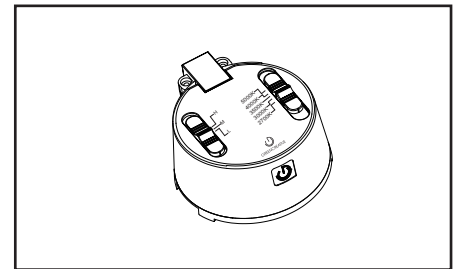

RETROFIT, DIRECT MOUNT AND NEW CONSTRUCTION INSTALLATION

SLFT4 is compatible with most standard plates with aperture ranging from 4-1/8" to 5-1/8".
 SLFT6 is compatible with most standard plates with aperture ranging from 6-1/8" to 7-1/2".
 SLFT8 is compatible with most standard plates with aperture ranging from 7-11/16" to 9-7/16".
 SLFT9.5 is compatible with most standard plates with aperture ranging from 8-11/16" to 10-9/16".

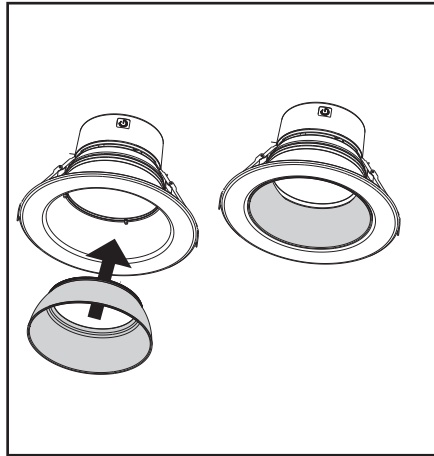
SELECTFIT DUALDIM ACCESSORIES INSTALLATION

TRIM INSERT (for 4", 6" and 8", SLFTx/CL/TRIM) and
WALL WASH (for 4" and 6" models, SLFTx/WW/ACC)

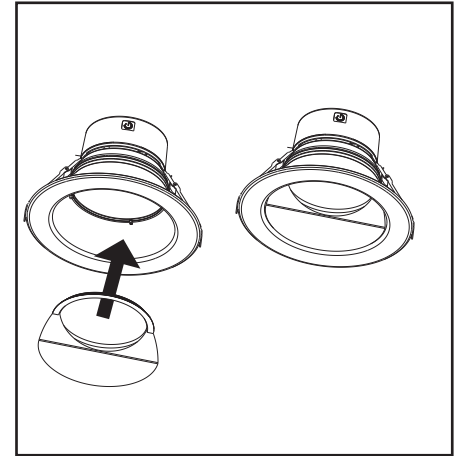
1. Locate the retainer clips at the edge of the top of the trim insert or wall wash insert. Locate the locking channel at the edge of the optical diffuser.
2. Insert and push the trim or wall wash inside the fixture until it clicks into the lens and is securely fasten. All retainer clips should be locked in the diffuser locking channel, and trim insert should be flush with the downlight reflector and flange.
3. For wall wash direct the open side toward the wall you want to graze.

Note: Trim insert and wall wash accessories can not be used together.

MEDIUM OPTIC (for 4", 6" and 8" models,
SLFTx/MD/OPTIC)

1. Detach the standard lens optic by rotating it counterclockwise, using the little grip holders if needed. Dispose the standard optical diffuser if not further needed.(fig. 1 & 2).
2. Once standard optic is removed, locate the retainers at the edge of the mixing chamber. Locate the hooking tab on the medium optics. (fig. 3).
3. Insert the lens in the downlight and turn clockwise to secure the lens with the mixing chamber, until it clicks and is firmly attached and secured. Flip the downlight facing downward to confirm the medium optic is secured. (fig. 4 & 5)

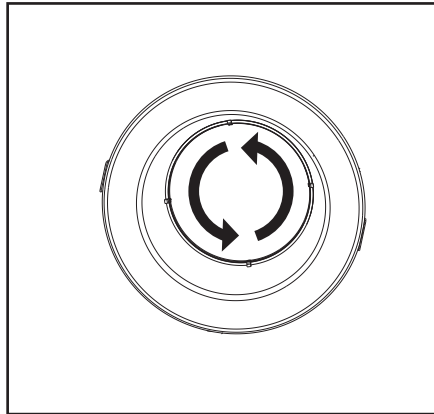

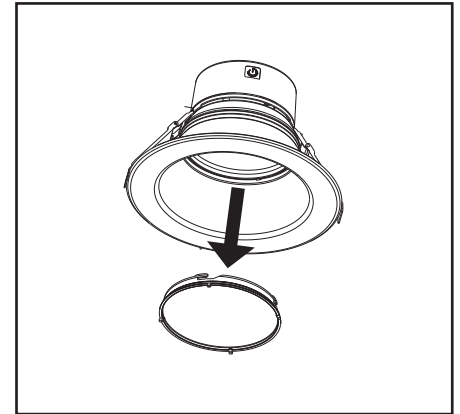

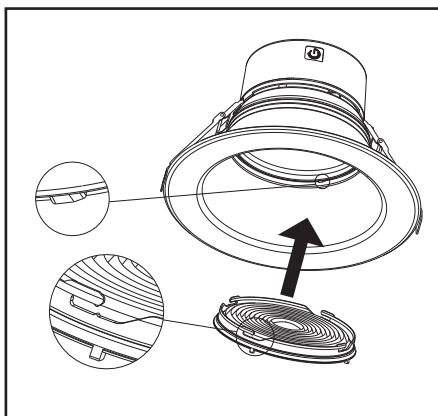
